

South Yarra Soccer Club - Player's Code of Conduct

South Yarra Soccer Club's ambition is to be regarded as a highly respected, community club. We strive to grow and develop to achieve success for our teams, club and community. We create a safe, supportive and positive environment that enables everyone to participate and contribute. We place a high importance on welcoming all people to our Club.

By becoming a member of South Yarra Soccer Club, all players are agreeing to:

- 1. Conduct themselves at all times in a respectful and sportsperson like manner.
- 2. Properly represent our Club and our community at all games and training sessions (home & away).
- 3. Not engage in disruptive or disrespectful behaviour during training sessions or games towards fellow teammates, other team's players, the coaches, the referees, or spectators, nor engage in any bullying, antagonism, foul or abusive language, or other intimidation of teammates or other team's players.
- 4. Pay Club registration fees in full prior to the start of the season players who are not paid up in full are not eligible for selection.
- 5. Do their best to attend all games and training sessions, and at all times follow the instructions of the coaches. If you are unable to make a session, please let your coach know.
- 6. Actively participate and foster a positive, co-operative playing environment, with a willingness to learn, participate in training and support other members.
- 7. Respect and look after all Club equipment, kit & facilities. Equipment is to be packed up properly after each session and placed in the correct storage area allocated to each team. Club changing rooms need to be cleaned out after use. This also applies when visiting opposition grounds.
- 8. Volunteer your time or services at least once over the course of the season. South Yarra are a community Club run by volunteer members and help is always needed either by volunteering in the canteen, organising fundraiser & social events, donations and services in kind.
- 9. Encouraged to participate in Club social events through the year, that help build and strengthen our community.

Note - your Football Victoria player registration includes public liability & limited personal injury insurance. Before signing on with the Club each season, players should familiarise themselves with the level of cover offered.
